JOB DESCRIPTION: The role of Curriculum Coordinator is to build teacher capacity and their understanding of instructional and assessment practices. The Curriculum Coordinator is responsible for assisting teachers in delivering high-quality instruction in classrooms through meetings, modeling, co-planning, and providing feedback. The Curriculum Coordinator will work with building principals to help meet needs in the area of curriculum.

SPECIFIC DUTIES: Duties will include, but are not limited to the following:

- Support the instructional development of all teachers in understanding the Indiana Academic Standards, instruction, technology-integration, grading, assessment, and other district initiatives.
- Provide support and coordination with principals for how curriculum is developed and implemented consistent with district initiatives and recognized best instructional practices.
- Work with principals to coordinate and facilitate grade level, department, and building meetings.
- Work with principals to plan professional development for teachers.
- Work with principals to plan summer school for students.
- Work with teachers and principals in the selection process of instructional materials and resources.
- Perform other duties assigned by the Superintendent.
