



# Rush County Schools Preschool

Rush County Schools is excited to announce that Preschool Registration for the 2020-2021 school year will open Monday, April 27th. We believe that preschool is an important part of a student's educational career. The goal of this program is to provide the foundational skills for reading and math readiness, as well as fine and gross motor skills, teamwork, and confidence in a school setting.

- ❖ Rush County Schools' preschool program is located at Rushville Elementary School West.
- ❖ The preschool program will follow the Rush County Schools' calendar.
- ❖ Students who will be 3 years old by August 1<sup>st</sup> will attend AM on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- ❖ Students who will be 4 years old by August 1<sup>st</sup> will attend either AM or PM on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- ❖ AM session times will be from 8:05-11:05. (Two-hour delay schedule 10:05-12:05)
- ❖ PM session times will be from 12:05-3:05. (Two-hour delay schedule 1:05-3:05)
- ❖ Class assignments will be made on a "first come, first served" basis upon receipt of the online preliminary registration form.
- ❖ Consistent attendance is an expectation of the preschool program. Continued absences may result in a student's spot being filled by a student on the waiting list.
- ❖ Parents of preschool students must provide his/her own transportation to and from school.
- ❖ Parents will receive information on their child's progress 2 times per school year.
- ❖ Preschool students must be potty-trained by the beginning of the school year.
