



Preschool-2nd Grade iPad Procedures

All K-2 grade level classrooms are supplied with classroom sets of iPads. Each student will be issued an iPad for use in the school building.

1. Receiving the iPad

1.1 Prior to students using an iPad for classroom activities, student pledges must be signed and submitted.

1.2 iPads will be used as an instructional tool and resource. These devices are property of Rush County Schools and will be assigned as a textbook is assigned for use during the school year.

2. Taking Care of the iPad

2.1 Only use a clean, dry or damp, soft cloth to clean the screen of the iPad. No cleansers of any type should be used.

2.2 Students and teachers must refrain from adding any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels to the iPads and cases.

2.3 Students must use both hands when carrying an iPad from one location to another.

2.4 iPads should be kept in the classroom carts when not in use.

3. Using the iPad

3.1 Content used on the iPad must be age appropriate, educationally appropriate and legal to use. Internet use on iPads will be filtered and monitored.

3.2 Additional classroom rules, pertaining to the use of the iPad, established by teachers must be followed.
